Objective: To motivate women scientists to contribute to the development of the country through

- (i) research, development and adaptation of technology for improving the quality of life and provide opportunities for income generation in urban slums or rural areas.
- (ii) Adaptation and transfer of an innovative technology form laboratory to field in rural areas. Under the scheme, projects will be considered from the scientist in areas of science, engineering or medicine.

The minimum essential qualifications are PG degree equivalent to M.Sc in basic or Applied Science.

Internship for Self-Employment (WOS-C)

The objective of this scholarship is to create a large pool of trained women workforce with experience in diverse areas and building up a professional network. National Award for Women's Development through Application of Science & Technology

This award is instituted to recognize the contributions of individuals/institutions who have worked at the grass root level for women's development through application of science and technology.

This prestigious award comprises of a memento, a cash prize of Rs.1.00 Lakh for individual and Rs. 10.00 Lakhs for institution with citation.

- Private institutions are in the lead for loan only. (So, collaborations are a must)
- Proposals should say the following very clearly:
 - i) Objectives ii) competence of the PI iii) Relevance iv) Methodology v) work plan and vi)User Agency
