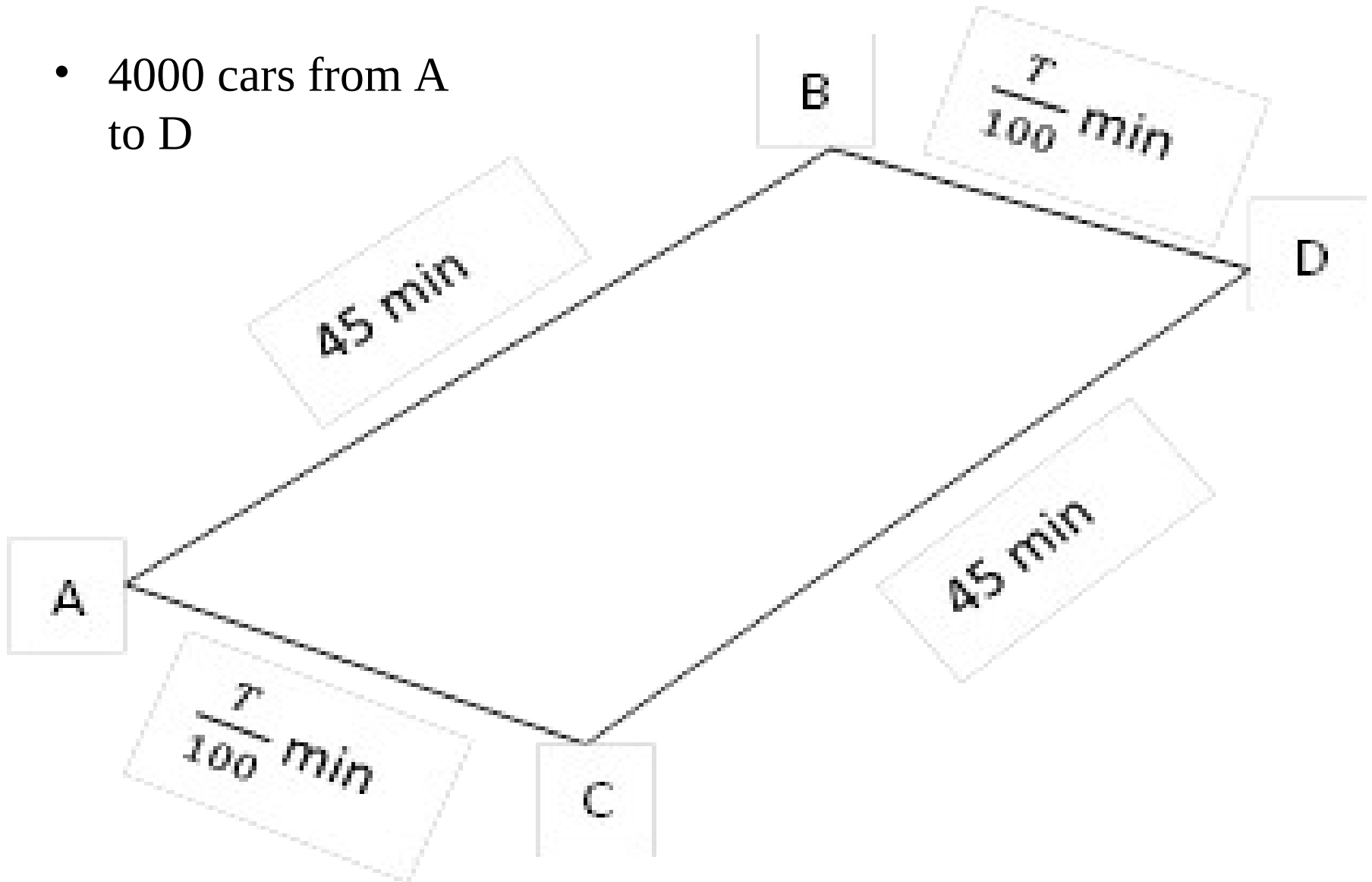

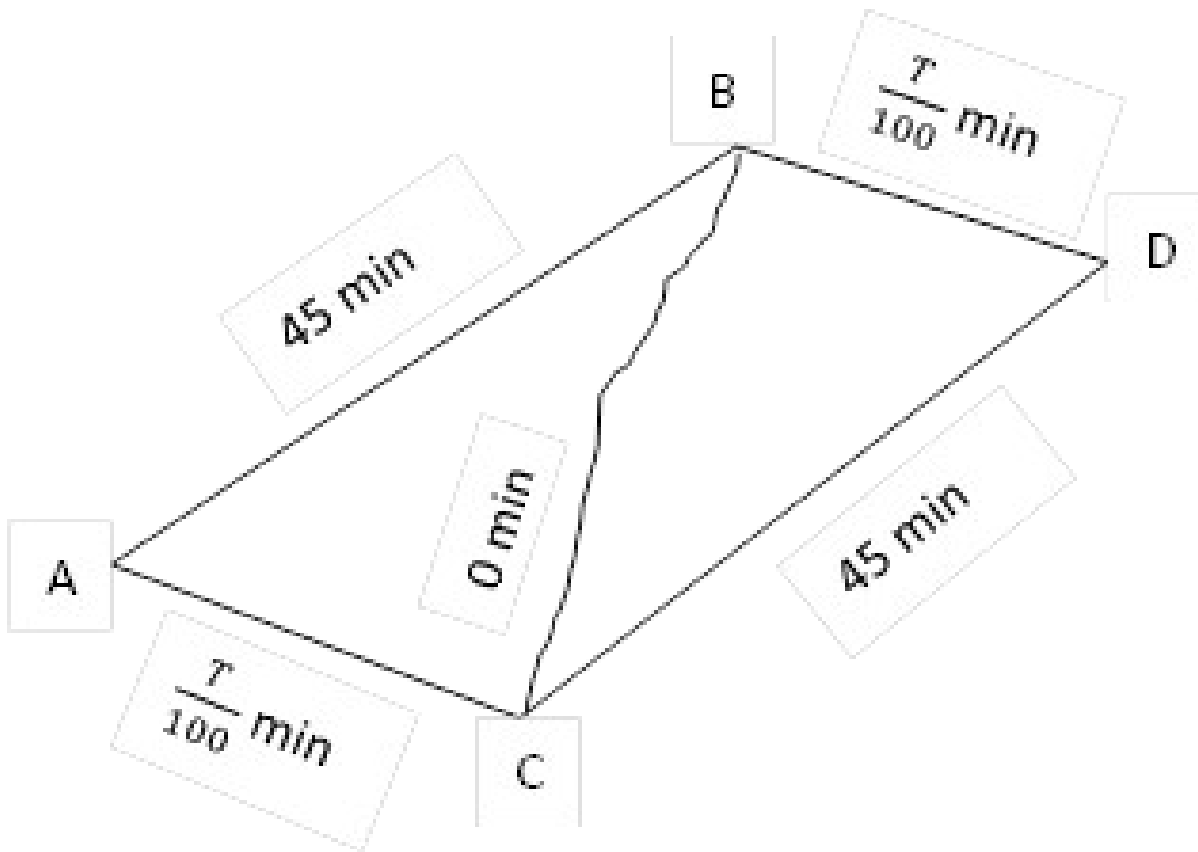

- 4000 cars from A to D



Braess' Paradox (contd.)



- Total time without link road is 65 minutes
- Total time with link road is 80 minutes

- Knowledge of mathematics keeps the thinking tight
- Mathematicians must know how to use their tools of analysis
- Mathematics is a tool for the corporate world and not an end in itself
