

The Institute welcomes applications for Post-doctoral fellowships in string theory and related topics. The fellowships are normally for one year, but can be extended by up to an additional year.

### **Qualification**

A PhD in Physics with research work done in string theory and related topics. At the time of appointment the applicant should have submitted his/her doctoral thesis.

### **Application materials**

The application should contain

- CV (including your contact details and Citizenship)
- Research statement
- List of publications.
- Please arrange for at least two, preferably three, reference letters from persons familiar with your research work.

### **Deadline**

All the application materials should be received by August 18, 2025.

### **Salary**

Post-doctoral fellowships come with salaries that range from Rs. 58,000 per month, in case for a fresh PhD, upto a maximum of Rs. 67,000 per month for candidates with 2+ years of post PhD experience. In addition a contingency grant of Rs. 60,000/year is provided. Medical coverage will be provided to the fellowship holder. While IMSc will attempt to provide furnished accommodation to all selected post-doctoral fellows, this is subject to availability. A house rent allowance (equal to 30% of the fellowship amount) can be provided in lieu of Institute accommodation.
